MANAGER'S REPORT 2019

I will get right into it for a few quick items before the Holiday weekend.

<u>Tennis Courts:</u> Due to the cool wet conditions, the new tennis court surface is not curing very quickly. We are anxious to utilize the new courts but <u>must not be on the courts for any purpose when they are wet or damp</u> as it will damage the new surface.

Exterior Building Repairs: Many projects are running behind due to weather but we anticipate beginning the exterior building repairs prior to re-paint on buildings 28 and 29.

<u>Gutters:</u> We continue to be pleased with the re-roofing project, unfortunately the weak link to the project has been the gutter work.

Many of you have expressed and/or experienced concerns related to the gutter work. Management has been working closely with Premier Roofing since early in the project to address the gutter related concerns.

For the Long Term; the good news is the gutter work carries the same 10 year workmanship warranty as the roofs. Of course we, Premier and Management will continue to work with the gutter contractor to minimize and resolve issues. If you have gutter related issues please contact the office or Chris Masi with Premier. Be very specific as to the concern and particularly the location.
